## EXCELLENT AIRCRAFT

Artisan members share two Instrument Cross-Country equipped airplanes. This ratio ensures high aircraft availability. Overnight and extended trips are encouraged, with no daily minimums.

Members have flown multi-week trips to Denver, Bahamas, Orlando and many other places.

Both aircraft are conscientiously maintained by careful tracking of PM intervals, both periodic (time-based) and usage (meter-based). Preventative maintenance is performed under the supervision of the Club Maintenance Officer; repairs conducted by a leading aviation maintenance organization, and oil submitted for analysis after each oil change. Members are active participants in this process through adherence to SOPs, and participation in Club meetings. Keeping the aircraft indoors year around and the availability of remote preheating improves the Artisan fleet dispatch reliability.

Maintenance Status and Time Logs are available online to members 24/7.

This gives us confidence launching into night IMC.
